 - Senate Bill 7026 requires the state to create a suspicious activity log which led to the creation of the App called Fortify Florida. It can be downloaded to any mobile device.
 - There is a simple four step process for entering any suspicious activity within the school district.
 - You can remain anonymous when reporting tips, there is no GPS enabled within the App.
 - Each school has an identified team of people who receive the tips. Multiple district staff receive tips, and law enforcement must respond to tips within 30 minutes, and the FDOE also has access.
 - All tips are reviewed to determine the response.
