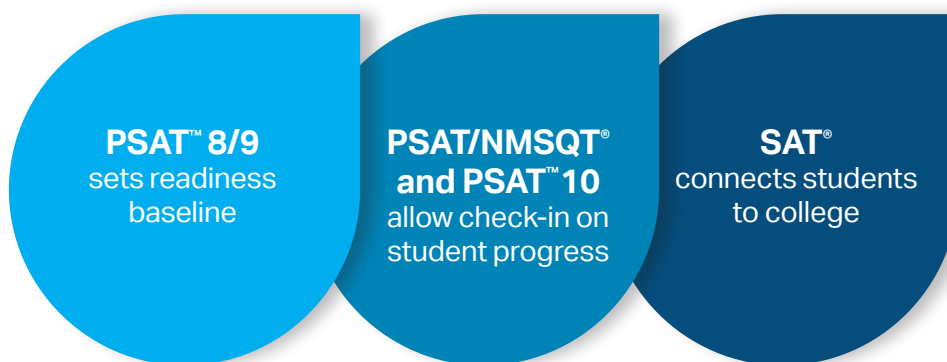

Scores from the SAT Suite are reported on a common vertical scale, allowing educators to measure student progress.

ACTIONABLE DATA

An online score-reporting portal gives educators helpful information about students' college and career readiness. Having this data earlier in a student's high school career lets educators intervene and set more of their students on the path to college and career readiness.

- ▶ Break down results by state, district, school, or student demographics.
