

Dear Parents/Guardians,

If you did not get an email with your child's homeroom teacher. **There is no need to email to ask for their teacher's name.** We will have a list to help those students, do not worry.

Signed up for our remind text alerts, see confirmation letter. Revisit the email sent earlier with areas where we need your help, both are on our website. Should busses arrive at drop off locations 15 minutes late or more I will send an alert. Thank you in advance for your patience on the first day.

Do not forget any medications listed on your application such as an epi pen or inhaler.

Please recheck the bus schedule as times and locations may have changed. Make sure your child knows what school their bus stop is located at so at dismissal they know what bus to ride. The school name is more important than a stop number or letter. Remind your child to look at the driver and other students so they are returning on the correct bus.

Masks will be worn during all bus transportation, with 49 maximum riders. Most classrooms are spaced correctly so students can remove their masks. Some classroom situations will require a mask, for example when doing work in pairs. If your child is wearing a paper mask if you are able please send extras because they can rip at the ear loops. Masks will not be worn outdoors. Remember our goal is to have student learning outside in our local environment. We will work to move to our in the field locations as quickly as possible for your child's comfort and learning experiences.

Send your child already in their bathing suit under their clothes. With covered heel and toe footwear.

Homeroom changes cannot take place. Thank you for encouraging your child to make new friends.

We are excited all the pieces have come together to allow our program to proceed. It will not be a success without your help in following all our guidelines.
