




Update from Mr. Greco in the Media Center...



Also, if anyone has a student with a reading IEP their child is eligible for Learning Ally, which is an audiobook format which reads the book and highlights the text as it is reading it. It is a very helpful support for struggling readers.



This year we are also encouraging all our students to read 20 minutes a day after school. Research shows that students that read 20 minutes per day can add 1.8 million words to their vocabulary and tend to score in the 90th percentile on standardized tests. Please help your child carve out that time each day.
