There was quite a few days of testing during December.

Early morning Learning Ally reading of The Van Gogh Deception for lowest quartile students.

Escape Room for all students who have read The Van Gogh Deception, very very popular incentive to read.

We had an "The Van Gogh Deception" based Escape Room for all the students that read the SSYRA book "The Van Gogh Deception" open at lunch times, a Mystery Skype session with our 8th graders for geography skills, and poetry to culminate with a Skype author visit in March. The Escape Room was one of the best incentives to get kids to read that I have ever had! Very happy with it and the kids had a great time.

Highlight of the month was when 140 7th grade students participated in a Learning Ally Author Skype visit with Kwame Alexander. Students could participate if they wrote their own poetry. We also continued to have the Escape Room open at lunch for students that have read "The Van Gogh Deception" SSYRA book.

Closed for testing for 4 days. Had great Mystery Skype sessions with a school in Colorado to improve geography and problem solving skills. Skype Collaboration sessions with a school in Columbia, South America with Spanish classes. Their students presented in English and Spanish and our students learned a lot about the culture of Columbia. The students there even shared traditional dances with us. Tested almost every day in May the remainder of the days I did inventory.

Got the 8th grade WEB students set up on their quarterly novel reading which is a goal to increase recreational reading for 8th graders. Great start to the year students reading more at all grade levels and research occurring at all grade levels.

We began the Minecraft competition of building our school using Minecraft for Education tools during all three lunches. We had to create 7 teams at one point due to the demand.

We had a successful book fair and additional Mystery Skype sessions. I was out of the library for one week so that did impact our circulation.
