FUNDS REQUEST

Katrina Stanton, ILC, requested funds for "Just Words" which is a research-based program to help fill in gaps in phonics for students who have low reading skills. There are 12 sets of student durables, along with a magnetic board and a white board. GRMS also needs some of the consumables. There is a great student buy-in because they experience success. The class size for reading remediation is 8-12 students. Ms. Stanton requested \$648. Linda Villadoniga moved to approve the funds request, Kim McManus and Lisa Calvert seconded the motion. The request was unanimously approved.
