### GAMBLE ROGERS MIDDLE SCHOOL SCHOOL ADVISORY COUNCIL MINUTES MARCH 27, 2025

#### WELCOME / SIGN IN

The meeting of the GRMS SAC was called to order by Chairperson Jaclyn Racano at 3:04 p.m.

#### **REVIEW/APPROVAL OF MINUTES**

The March meeting minutes were distributed and reviewed. The adjournment time was not listed. Ms. Racano indicated that she would go back through her notes and include that in the minutes that are forwarded to District. Secretary Linda Villadóniga had not attended the meeting, therefore the minutes submitted by her were taken from the transcript which did not include the time that the meeting was adjourned.

#### PRINCIPAL UPDATE AND BUDGET

Principal Brian Wilson gave the budget report. We presently have \$1389.30.

Mr. Wilson indicated that we had not finished our Mission and Vision statements. He will get some feedback from the faculty and staff and report back to SAC.

It is budget season and the District is working on its budget which impacts each school's budget for next school year. The District is opening a new Charter School at our end of the county. We don't know what the impact of that school will have on GRMS.

The budget impacts staffing for the next school year. Staffing impacts the number of courses we can offer and also the subject matter of the courses. We try to give the students their first choice of electives, but we can't give them everything they want so sometimes it goes to their second choice. We have a solid drama and music program.

#### **GRMS UPDATES**

Mr. Wilson gave the following GRMS updates:

We just lost an art teacher but we're hiring a new one. Our Art Department is also a strong program. We also have a STEM teacher and an ICT teacher.

Spanish is offered at every grade level, but not every student can or wants to take advantage of that. Students who take Spanish in 8<sup>th</sup> grade get a Spanish I credit if they achieve at least a C in the course. Students who take Spanish in 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grades will also get Spanish 1 credit if they meet the C requirement.

Students can also get high school credit for Biology and Math if they take the appropriate courses and achieve a C or better.

Our AVID and PBIS programs are going strong.
