**Due to there not being a quorum, the regular monthly meeting of the Gamble Rogers Middle School SAC was not held in January. However, some information was shared with those attending.**

**Mr. Wilson informed the group that there had been change in the budget. He also said that there was no new data to share. Some tweaking of the PBIS plan is taking place. For example, donuts were going to be served to 2 random classrooms for perfect attendance the following day. This activity can be expanded as needed.**

**Ms. Racano gave a brief presentation on some SAC updates (as directed by the School District). There must be 50% + 1 of SAC members present in order to hold a meeting and hold a vote. Virtual members cannot vote. SAC surveys will be tweaked to add some questions if deemed necessary by the team. There are questions that are set by the District Office and cannot be changed.**

**Public Comment: Ms. Collins, School Board Rep congratulated Ms. Cruppi and Ms Holtman on being chosen Gamble's Teacher of the Year and Rookie Teacher of the Year respectively. They will be honored at an event later this evening.**

**Ms. Romano announced the reading theme of the month "Read, White and Blue" . There will be an "Explain a book badly" competition as well as a Door Decorating contest to get students involved. There will also be an author's visit after school. There is a word wall highlighting different subject areas.**

**Ms. Bohanan told us that 100 + non-fiction books have been added to the GRMS library (including an update of books dealing with the planets) as well as some new graphic novels. The titles of 100 books has been sent to the Advisory Council for approval.**
