

# GRMS Updated Safety Information 9.9.2020

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## Safety Rules for Returning to GRMS

Is your child currently awaiting COVID-19 test results?

If yes, please keep your child home and notify the school nurse when test results received. Further instructions will be discussed at that time.

Does your child live in the same household with someone positive for COVID-19?

If yes, your child must quarantine for 14 days from the last date of contact with the positive individual. A negative test result does not reduce the quarantine requirement for the full 14 day incubation period.

Has your child had close contact with someone who in the past 14 days who tested positive for COVID-19?

If yes, your child must quarantine for 14 days from the last date of contact with the positive individual. A negative test result does not reduce the quarantine requirement for the full 14 day incubation period.

# Brick & Mortar Procedures



## Morning Procedures

Parents please assess your child daily for the following symptoms:

- Fever of 100.4 or higher
- Cough
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- Sore throat
- Loss of sense of smell or taste
- Muscle aches
- Does anyone in your household have any of the above signs/symptoms right now?
- Has your child had close personal contact with anyone confirmed or suspected with COVID-19?

*If your child is experiencing any of these symptoms, please keep them home and contact your local health professional.*

## Arrival and Homeroom Procedures

7:10 students enter the building and temperature checks begin for students at breakfast

7:20 – 7:26 Release to Homerooms for temperature checks by their homeroom teacher prior to entering the classroom

7:30 Homeroom begins and attendance is taken

***\*Any student coming in after 7:30 will be considered tardy.***

### Mask Protocols

Masks must be worn at all times when unable to social distance and must fully cover the mouth and nose

- Students may remove their masks when behind their desk shields and not interacting with others in the room
- Students will be required to wear masks while changing classes or using common areas of the school including bathrooms
- Students will not be required to wear masks if able to social distance in the classroom

### Front Office Procedures

**\*An appointment will be required to enter the school building using all safety precautions (mask, temperature check, questionnaire)**

Check out procedures:

- Parent must display their ID to the camera and clearly state their student's full name and grade
- Parent will wait outside until the student is brought to them (check out is restricted within the last half hour of our school day)

Item Drop off:

- Ring the bell with ID displayed
- Forgotten items need to be bagged and clearly marked with the student's full name and grade level prior to drop off at the school

# Brick & Mortar Procedures



## Transitions

We will be using a staggered dismissal between classes

Masks: Masks are to be worn in the hallways by teachers and students

Water Fountains: Students will be required to use the refillable water bottle filling stations in lieu of the drinking fountains (a water bottle will be provided to each student).

## School Safety and Sanitation Procedures

Lockers will not be assigned or used this year in the classroom.

- Prior to school occupancy, all spaces will be cleaned and sanitized
- The omni shield mist will be used in classrooms and is capable of killing the virus for up to 90 days
- Filters will be replaced in Mechanical HVAC systems with MERV 13 or higher rating to help with air circulation.
- During school occupancy cleaning and disinfection procedures will be conducted in accordance to CDC Guidelines.
- As an added precaution, frequently touched surfaces will be cleaned periodically throughout the day utilizing disinfectants listed for use on COVID-19.

## Lunch Safety Procedures

Mask Requirements:

- Students must wear their mask at all times, unless eating

Lunch:

- Seating will be in the Cafeteria and our Multi-purpose room to allow more spacing
- Students will have assigned seating
- If a student forgets their lunch clearly mark their name & grade prior to drop off

\*Parents **will not** be permitted to drop off food from outside sources to their student during the school day

- This includes fast food/restaurant meals
- This DOES NOT include lunch boxes that students may have left at home

## School Dismissal

Staggered dismissal will be announced over the PA

- Parent Pick up First
- By Grade Level

•After school students must wear their mask from the building and continue to wear it until they get off the bus or into their parent's vehicle
