

GRMS Updated Return to Brick & Mortar 9.9.2020

Dear GRMS Families:

We've had a very positive start. Thank you for being prepared and patient! As we all get acquainted with a new way of learning, it is important to allow time for adjustment to the routines and expectations. We know you committed to the model that would best suit your family.

In the event you need to request a change from Distance Learning to Brick & Mortar or vice versa, our process is outlined below.

- If requesting a move to Brick & Mortar, loaner devices provided by the school will be collected.*

Schools will review requests each Thursday.

Families will be advised of decisions on Friday.

Students will continue participating in their current model until notified of the new placement.

Please note that a schedule change and/or teacher change may be necessary when a student moves from one model to the other.

Instruction will have two formats based on the day of the week

Monday, Tuesday, and Friday

- Students will log on to schoology at 7:30 and complete assignments in the order of their scheduled courses
- Students must complete daily assignments by the end of the school day (2:00) to be marked present for that course
- Students will have instruction in one of these formats:
 - pre-recorded lessons to access and an interactive activity to complete
 - live sessions with teachers (teachers will state which model in their weekly update post on Monday)

Wednesday and Thursday

- Students will log on to schoology at 7:30 and complete assignments in the order of their scheduled courses
 - All classes will be live lessons within schoology, students must log in at the beginning of each course at the designated time
 - Attendance will be taken at the beginning of the live session
