
WHAT IS A YEAR-LONG ELECTIVE?

Advanced elective classes for the 6th graders who already have a passion or interest in a specific area.

Students will be in the same class all year.

Courses may have fees, supplies, or after school requirements.

*No student will be turned away for financial reasons.













- No prior experience necessary.
- Participation in concerts is expected.
- Some after school practices may be necessary.
- Possible instruments: Flute, oboe, clarinet, alto saxophone, French horn, trumpet, trombone, euphonium, tuba, or percussion

- No prior voice lessons or singing experience necessary.
- Participation in concerts is expected.

- Musical theatre incorporates singing and dance.













• SJMSAA (St. John's Middle School Athletic Association):






The elective application closes March 4th, 2024.
