LEVEL 1 OFFENSES



LEVEL 2 OFFENSES

Tardiness

-Student is not in the classroom prior to the tardy bell ringing.

Insubordination

-Failure or refusal to follow directions of school staff, school rules, classroom rules, or behavioral contracts. may be escalated to Level 2 or 3 based on severity.

Dress Code

-Student wears something not aligned with the SJCSO dress code. i.e., hats, hoods, revealing clothing, or inappropriate language.

Classroom Disruption

-Saying or doing something that keeps the teacher from teaching or other students from learning. May be Level 2 based on severity.

Profanity / Verbal Altercation

-Student uses profanity directed towards an adult or student with the intent to disrespect, degrade, or embarrass the victim.

Inappropriate Conduct

-Behavior that is inconsistent with school expectations for growth, respect, mindfulness, and safety. Behavior that is not appropriate student behavior, including actions that disrupt learning or negatively impact others.

Skipping Class

-Student fails to attend class without a note from a parent/guardian or doctor. This includes leaving the classroom or the school campus without permission. May be level 3 based on severity.

Repeated Level 1 Offenses

-Depending on the severity or frequency of Level 1 offenses, disciplinary actions could move to Level 2 consequences.

Teacher/Staff Will...

1. Redirect student behavior
2. Issue a classroom consequence
3. Contact parent or guardian
4. Write referral

Reminder:

To participate in trips, dances, and PBIS events students may not have OSS or more than 2 days of ISS.

Progressive Discipline for Level 1

- 1st Offense: Dean Conference
- 2nd Offense: Lunch Detention (1)
- 3rd Offense: Lunch Detention (2)
- 4th Offense: Parent/Guardian Conference
- 5th & 6th Offense: In-School Suspension
- 7th + Offense: Loss of trip, dance, and event privileges. Consider level 2 consequences.

Progressive Discipline for Level 2

- 1st Offense: In-School Suspension
- 2nd Offense: In-School Suspension
- 3rd Offense: Out of School Suspension and loss of school and event privileges
- 4th Offense: Out of School Suspension
- *** All steps can be skipped depending on the magnitude of the offense.

Any 8th grade student who receives a Level IV Referral for the any part of the school year, will not be eligible to participate in the end of year promotion ceremony or 8th grade formal.
