Rising 6th Graders: Updated **proof of residency** must be provided, and the **Returning Student Verification (RSV)** completed for your student to have a schedule on the first day of school. Rising 7th Graders: The **Returning Student Verification (RSV)** must be completed for your student to have a schedule on the first day of school. The **TDaP immunization or religious exemption** is required before your child can start 7th grade. When you complete the RSV online you can upload your proof of residency at the same time. Transportation:

If parents have a split custody agreement and both live in the GRMS zone, a new Provisional Transportation Waiver will need to be submitted at the beginning of each school year.

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July 22nd -23rd – Schedule Preview Day:

Students who have all residency documentation updated will be able to see their schedules for the 26-27 school year. After July 23rd, they will be shut off to begin the leveling process, but your classes will be the same, but possibly in a different order and/or different teacher. You will have the opportunity to request a schedule change based on the following criteria outlined in our schedule change procedures.

Orientation times are based on alphabet due to parking being limited at GRMS – please use the front gravel lot as well as the parking lot behind the school.

During the district open house, you can walk the campus, meet your teachers, turn in your Code of Conduct, sign up for the PTO, and buy spirit wear.

Please either print your schedule at home prior to coming or pull up your schedule on HAC and screenshot it on your phone. Do this prior to coming to the school building as cell service inside the building may not be available based on your carrier. If you pull up your schedule on HAC, you will need to click on classes and then click on schedule to be able to see the teachers AND room numbers. We will not be handing out printed schedules.

For safety reasons, we will not be handing out school maps. However, we will have WEB leaders and administration stationed around the campus to help point you in the right direction.
